

Mr. Douglas Frank “Dee” Stewart III of Raleigh, North Carolina is a successful political consultant and public affairs consultant.

Dee has served as President of The Stewart Group, Inc., a political consulting firm, since 2001, and has been a Partner in Strategic Partners Solutions, LLC, an issue management firm, since 2011. His companies have run hundreds of successful political campaigns for Republican elected officials in North Carolina, as well as hundreds of public affairs campaigns for America's Fortune 500 corporations and leading trade associations.

Dee’s political resume includes serving as National Youth Director of Phil Gramm for President in 1995-96; Finance Director of the North Carolina Republican Party from 1997-99; Executive Director of the Republican Party of Iowa from 1999-2001; Chief of Staff in the Office of Congressman Patrick McHenry in 2005; the General Consultant for Patrick McHenry from 2002-2025 (for NC House and U.S. Congress); and the General Consultant for Richard Hudson for Congress in 2012.

Dee was named a Rising Star by Campaigns and Elections Politics Magazine in 2008 and he received the Order of the Longleaf Pine, North Carolina’s highest civilian honor, in 2016.

Dee resides in Raleigh, North Carolina with his son, Douglas Frank “Dugan” Stewart IV. The Stewarts are members of Saint Timothy’s Episcopal Church in Raleigh. Dee earned a Bachelor of Arts in Government in 1995 and a Master of Business Administration with a Management concentration in 2003, both from Campbell University in North Carolina.

A lifelong Republican, Dee’s great-great grandfather is the late Congressman William Harrison Graham, a Republican who represented Pennsylvania’s 23rd Congressional District from 1898-1903 and Pennsylvania’s 29th Congressional District from 1905-1911.
